The senate approved guidelines vide item no. 74.11 and further revision in eligibility criteria vide item no. 86.8 towards Ph.D. admission under Extensive Professional Experience are given below:

1. Candidates working only in government organizations/laboratories, PSUs, and reputed companies should be considered.
2. Eligibility criteria should be as follows:

Candidate having M.Tech. / M.Arch. / M.U.R.P. / M.Pharm. / MS (Research) / Post-Graduate degree in Medical Sciences / Equivalent degree with at least 12 years of professional experience.

OR

Candidate having B.Tech./ B.Arch./ MBA / M.Sc. / B.Pharm / Graduate degree in Medical Sciences / equivalent degree with at least 14 years of professional experience.

3. Candidates should have demonstrated research potential through research papers in reputed journals / patents / technology transfer.
4. The Pre PhD course credit requirement would be as per the current practice for Part-Time candidates.
5. The credit requirement as recommended by the SRC, can be completed in the form of project/dissertation/seminar, NPTEL online courses.
6. There would be no residency requirements for such candidates.
7. Applications in this category can be made throughout the year to the office of Head of the concerned Department. The application should clearly mention the preferred area of work and choice of supervisor (if any). The candidate would be asked to give a presentation of his professional credentials in the concerned Department. The Head of the Department will seek inputs on the application from the faculty members working in the concerned area. The name of the proposed supervisor along with the recommendations of extended DRC (with faculty members of the same specialization as special invitees) should be sent to the office of DAA.

The selection would be recommended on the basis of interaction by the following 3-member committee:

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| 1. Dean Academic Affairs | - | Chairman |
| 2. Dean SRIC | - | Member |
| 3. Head of the concerned Department | - | Member |

The final approval on the recommendations will be accorded by the Chairman, Senate.

The details of the Ph.D. admission procedure under 'Extensive Professional Experience Scheme' are given below:

1. The candidate needs to submit their application to the HoD / HoC in which he / she wants to pursue the Ph.D. study. The application should include identified/proposed area of research work, facilities for carrying out the research work, etc.

The following documents should be attached with the application letter:

- a. NOC from the parent organization / institute.
 - b. Detailed resume with qualification and experience.
 - c. Self-attested copy of all the educational qualification.
 - d. Copy of the papers published in the reputed journals, if any.
 - e. Details and copy of the Patents (s) or application submitted for Patentship, if any.
 - f. Documents related to Transfer of Technology (TOT), if any.
 - g. Service particulars of the candidate from the present organization and previous organization(s), if any issued in the official letter-head. Service particulars should incorporate yearwise details of designation / post(s) held by the candidate.
2. Candidates shall be called by the concerned Department / Centre for presentation before the extended department Research Committee (DRC) / Centre Research Committee (CRC). Presently, online presentation can be conducted.
 3. On recommendation of the said DRC / CRC, the candidate will be required to appear for Interaction before the designated committee.
 4. Offer letter for Ph.D. admission shall be issued after the final approval of the competent authority.
